



SACG Special Meeting

March 15, 2022

Library, lower level

President Marlys Harms called this meeting to order at 6:00 PM. We had 17 members present.

The special meeting was called by Jim Hiding to present the budget for installing a pickleball court in Memorial Park as part of the application process for the AARP Community Challenge Grant. Jim presented two options with varying types of surfaces. The cost difference between the two options was just under \$11,000. That said, Jim suggested the lower cost option using concrete and a colored acrylic coating instead of the more expensive Versacourt tile system.

Jim pointed out the average AARP grant is \$11,000 and this project will cost \$32,600. In an effort to bring the grant request more in line with AARP's past history, and to demonstrate that SACG is willing to invest some of its own money, Jim proposed SACG invest enough money to bring the grant request to below \$20,000. Tim Peters motioned for SACG to provide up to \$13,000, which was seconded by Dan Pence. All Ayes.

An anonymous donor is generously providing \$2,000 toward this project, which will be used for cost increases and unforeseen expenses on a project of this size.

We adjourned at 6:27 PM.
